5.1 The ARCS Charter Council will discuss budgeting scenarios to achieve a balanced site program budget for 2020/21: Budget Presentation by Sid Albaugh: Black Oak Mine USD Chief Financial Officer

Syd presented Scenario #4 Proposal and a fully funded scenario as well as Estimated Actuals from 2019-2020. Please see attached documents. Syd began his presentation by explaining that all districts are under budget cuts at this time and we won't know the final numbers until it is determined by the State. He discussed the separation of ARCS site and homeschool programs. For 20-21 school year, the charter will be treated as one program to allow the site program to get back on its feet financially. The state treats charter schools differently and does not allow them the "hold harmless" for declines in ADA. BOMUSD expects declines in the fall due to COVID-19. Currently, we expect a 10% deficit, but there's hope that the legislature will agree to fully fund. We have to go forward with finding a scenario that will address the ongoing financial issues. A Re-entry Task Force has been formed in BOMUSD and all interested parties may participate.
